Calls for Public Proposals and Views

The Sub-Committee appointed on 06 May 2026 to prepare a research report on the Restructuring of the Sri Lanka Institute of Advanced Technological Education is chaired by **Hon. Ruwan Mapalagama, MP**, and consists of **Hon. Arjuna Sujeewa Senasinghe, Attorney-at-Law, MP** and **Hon. Lt. Cmdr. (Rtd.) Prageeth Madhuranga, MP**. The Sub-committee intends to obtain views from all interested parties and will focus primarily on the following matters:-

1. Making maximum use of the resources available at the Sri Lanka Institute of Advanced Technological Education
2. Enrolling students in courses at a higher rate
3. Issues relating to retention of students in the courses and the gaps in the student welfare arrangements, and improving the employability of those who complete the courses
4. Identifying the real labour needs of the job market
5. Taking into consideration the challenges faced by educational institutions located in remote areas
